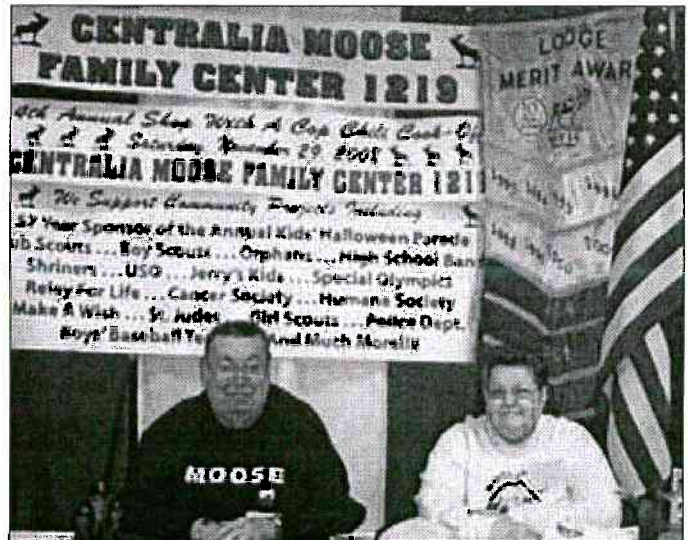
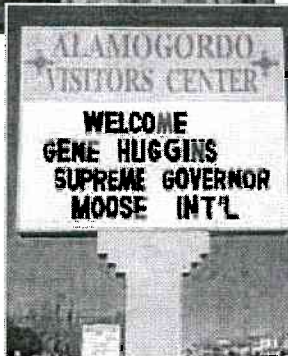
This Moose is Also Governor!

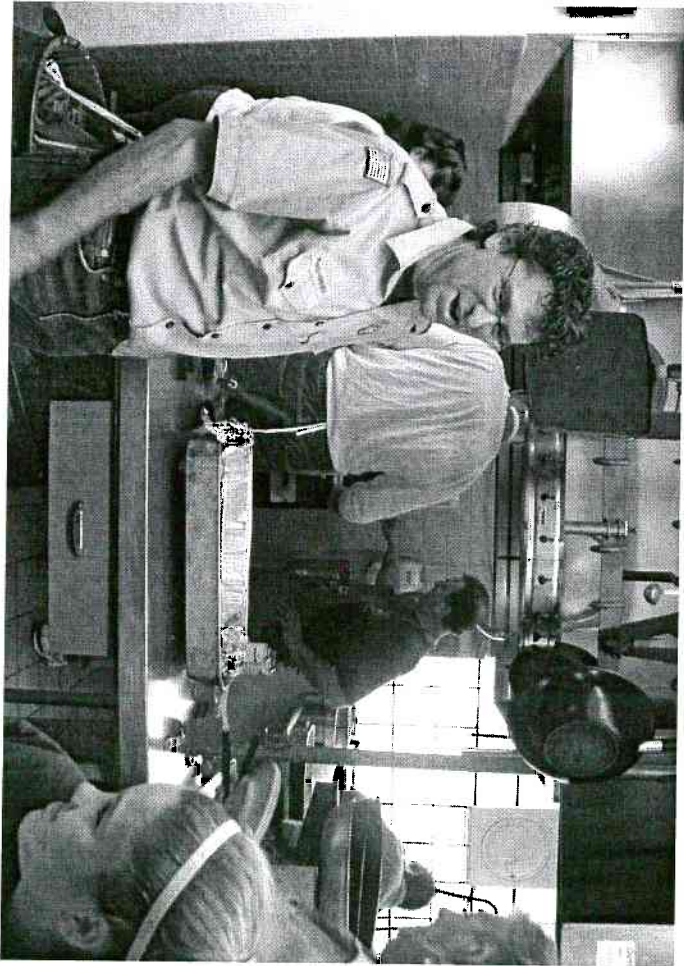
Downers Grove, IL 1535 Enrolls Another 42 New Members
