Big Party Easter Sunday for Kids

Featuring a complete new program, including change of time, the annual Easter party of Downers Grove Moose Lodge 1535 will be held in the club rooms of the Lodge on Sunday, April 13.

While plans are not yet completed, the Easter party committee, headed by Chairman John Watts and consisting of Lloyd Senkbile and Chester Patula, have already made the following announcements:

1. The party, for the first time in its history dating back over many years, will be held in the afternoon with festivities scheduled to begin at 2 p. m. Reason for the change of time of the party was to eliminate conflict with religious obligations of Moose members and their families.
2. The party this year will feature more entertainment

for the kiddies with a greatly de-emphasized program of prizes for those attending.

Tentatively planned thus far for the entertainment of those attending are a clown act and the sleight-of-hand of a magician designed to mystify and intrigue the interest of the kids on hand. The traditional Easter basket will be given to every kiddie attending.

It is also the feeling of the committee that cooperation of the membership on this regulation will also assure a much better party for the kiddies attending.
