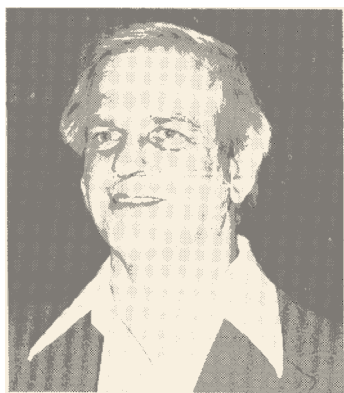
I want to thank George Sterka and his crew for running the Chicken Dinner and Mike Zielak and his crew for the Steak Dinner.

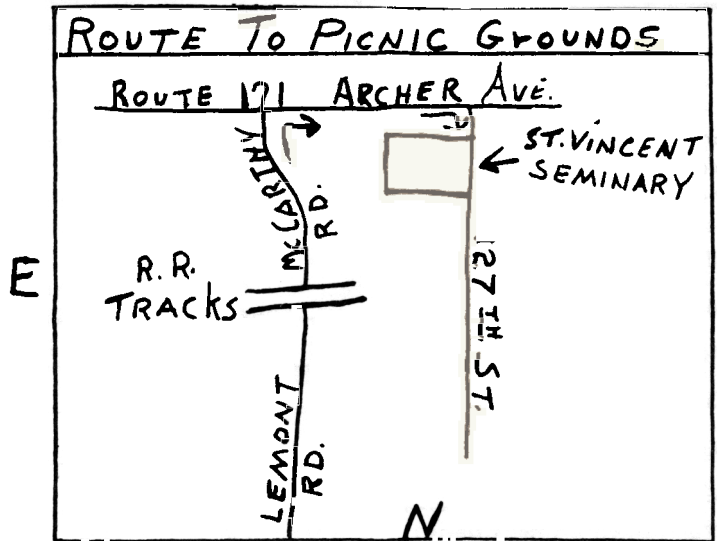
