Lodge Cookbook Needs Your Recipes!

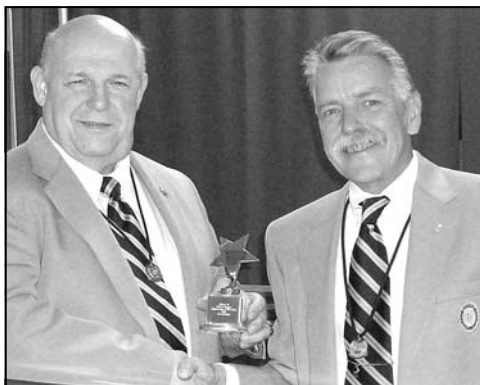

Moose Cycle Races Rules

- Any dice rolled off the table will be rerolled.
- Caller will chose which set of dice to use.
- All wagering is final when called to the post.
- In the event of a tie, a single die will be rolled until a single winner is awarded.
- Moose Riders or other Lodge unit that chooses to run a race is authorized to retain up to 50% of proceeds for their cause. It is preferred, however, that winners receive a minimum of twice their wager.
- The Lodge unit or person running the race may opt for a 100% payout.
- All wagers are to be made and paid out in even dollar amounts.
- Wagers may be made as high as the crowd will allow.
- As the Moose Cycles are wood, they may ONLY be pushed with the rod intended for that use so that no damage occurs.
- Caller may NOT touch the dice while in play.
- Only Members and their qualified guests may participate.
